Description

In this “hands-on” course you will learn how to design web pages using Adobe Dreamweaver CS5. Students are expected to have a basic understanding of Windows. (Experience with HTML is helpful.)

The class will meet once a week for four weeks in the computer lab. Each class lasts three hours. During the first part of the class I’ll present new material and show examples that we’ll try together. The remaining time is reserved for working on the assignment.

- A: Attend all classes and submit *all* four of the assignments correctly.
- B: Attend at least three classes and submit three of the assignments correctly.
- C: Attend at least two classes and submit two of the assignments correctly.
- Pass: Attend at least two classes and submit at least two of the assignments correctly.
