Course Description

This course builds on what we learned in HTML-1. Students are expected to have basic knowledge of computer operation. At a minimum you should know how to edit text files, copy files, and use a Web browser such as Internet Explorer or Firefox.

Class Description

The class consists of a lecture, demonstrations, and in-class exercises. *Since this is a hands-on course, attendance is strongly encouraged.* We meet once a week for four weeks. Each class lasts three hours.

Books and References

No books are required for this class; the Web is rich with tutorials and references on HTML. Your work will be lost when the computer is turned off. Please email you files to yourself or save to a flash drive.
